



## **JOB OPPORTUNITY**

### **RESIDENTIAL EDUCATOR** **REPLACEMENT WITH POSSIBILITY OF RENEWAL**

#### **GENERAL:**

Under the supervision of the Team Leader and authority of the Executive Director, the Residential Educator will carry on the activities in the addiction rehabilitation program. Being responsible for the implementation of the intervention plan as prescribed by the clinical team the Residential Educator will introduce and apply learned techniques favoring the teaching of appropriate attitudes and behaviors of the youth. Following Individuals Plan of Intervention and application of client`s objectives in recovering from addiction.

#### **Specific Functions:**

- Ensures the integration and orientation of the clients upon arrival and accordingly with the procedures defined in the program.
  - Collaborates to the need assessments of the clients.
  - Ensures that the immediate environment and facilities favours the rehabilitation and wellbeing of the clients.
  - Participates to the elaboration of the intervention plans and ensures the pursuing of the individual rehabilitation as defined in program.
  - Organize and animate activities related to the need of the clients
  - Produce and forwards, written observations, evaluation reports, daily journal log book and other required documents and entering data into informatics program.
- Animate, facilitate meetings, when providing after care services and / or outreach services travelling to diverse communities, by collaborating with referral agents and client`s family.
- Communicate all necessary information to the immediate supervisor.

#### **Requirements**

- Post secondary degree; CEGEP or University, preferably a certificate in youth intervention or other related fields such as addiction counselling, social sciences, and juvenile delinquency, education.
- Minimum of 2 years relevant experience working in the addiction field and working with youths and their family.
- Good communication skills; proficient in English and French including the ability to write basic reports and preferably and oral ability in an Aboriginal language.
- Lived experience in First Nations communities is an asset as in knowledge of diverse First Nations.
- Of good reputation and of free substance abuse.
- Preference to employ Aboriginal persons provided that requirements for the position are met.
- Must produce written confirmation of clearance of criminal record.
- Must have a Driver`s license.
- Available to work of shift schedules, including some shift in evenings and weekends.
