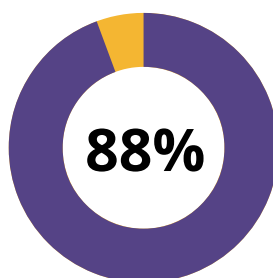

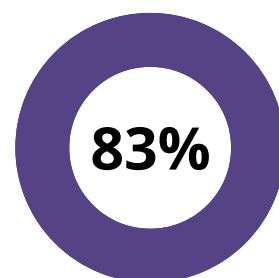
82% of those surveyed remember being informed of their rights at entry.

Youth who achieve sustained success in their healing journey, with the full support of community partners

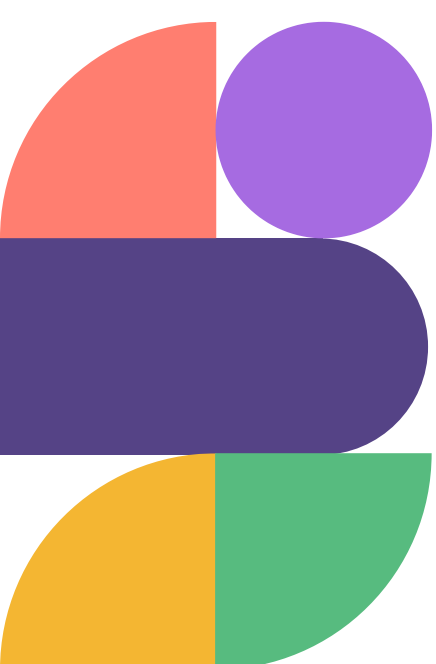
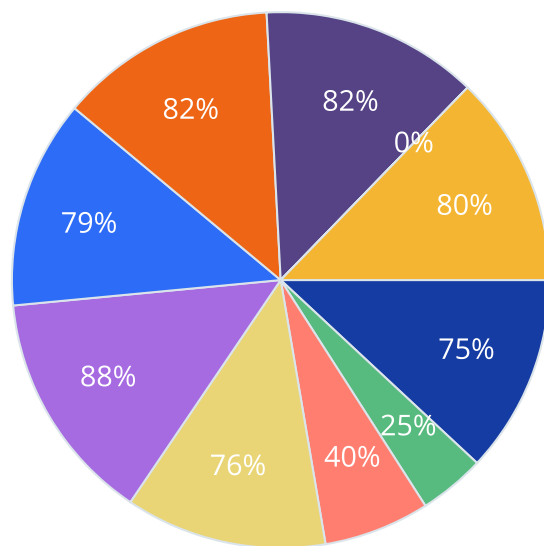


Evidence Informed
