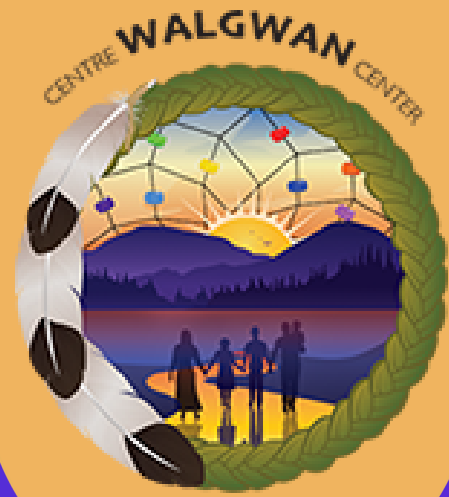


Youth Care Worker
